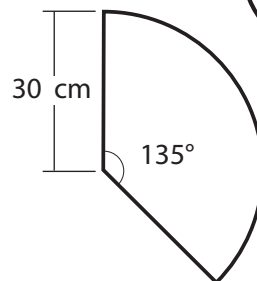


Clown costume

Follow the steps to make a clown costume.

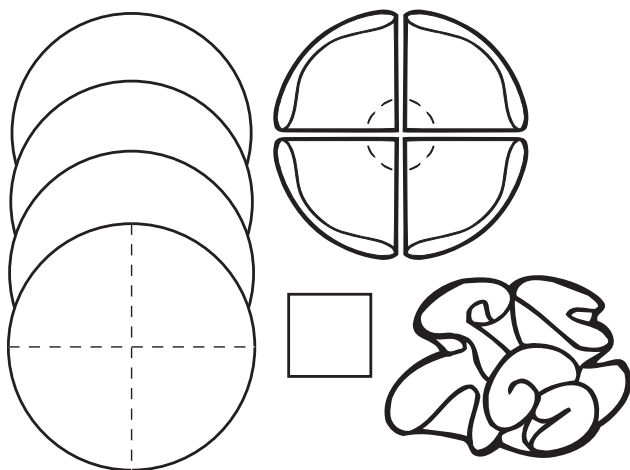
1 Clown hat

- Enlarge the template to the correct size.
- Join to form a cone shape and secure with tape.



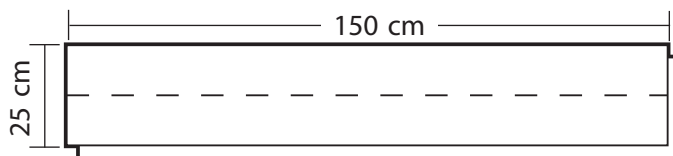
2 Pompoms

- Cut 4 circles of crepe paper.
- Fold each circle into quarters.
- Staple at the centre onto a small square of card.
- Gently open each circle.
- Glue or staple securely to clown hat.



3 Clown neck ruff

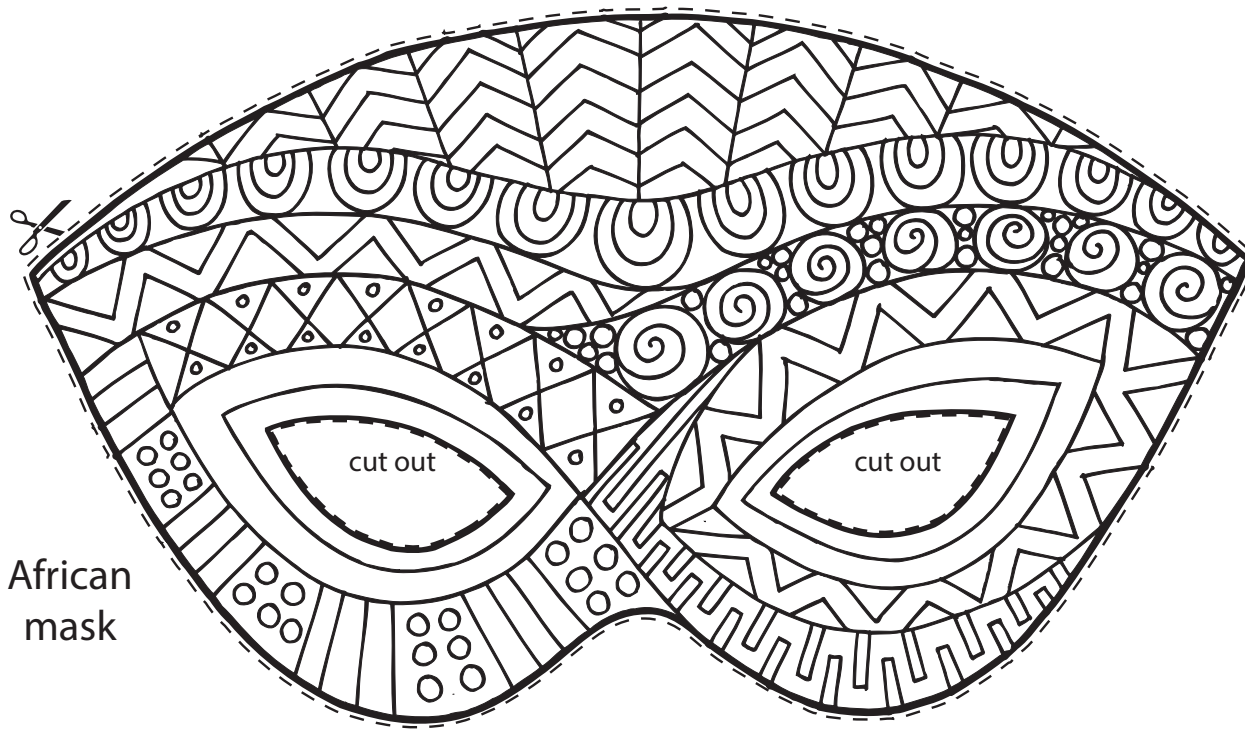
- Cut a length of crepe paper 150 cm long.
- Fold it in half lengthways and cut down the fold line in the centre.
- Lay both pieces on top of each other and make a fold line down the centre.
- Use a needle with a large eye and a length of thin ribbon or tape to stitch down the centre line.
- Leave some tape at each end.
- Gently pull up the tape to gather the layers.
- Use the ends of the tape to tie the ruff around the neck.



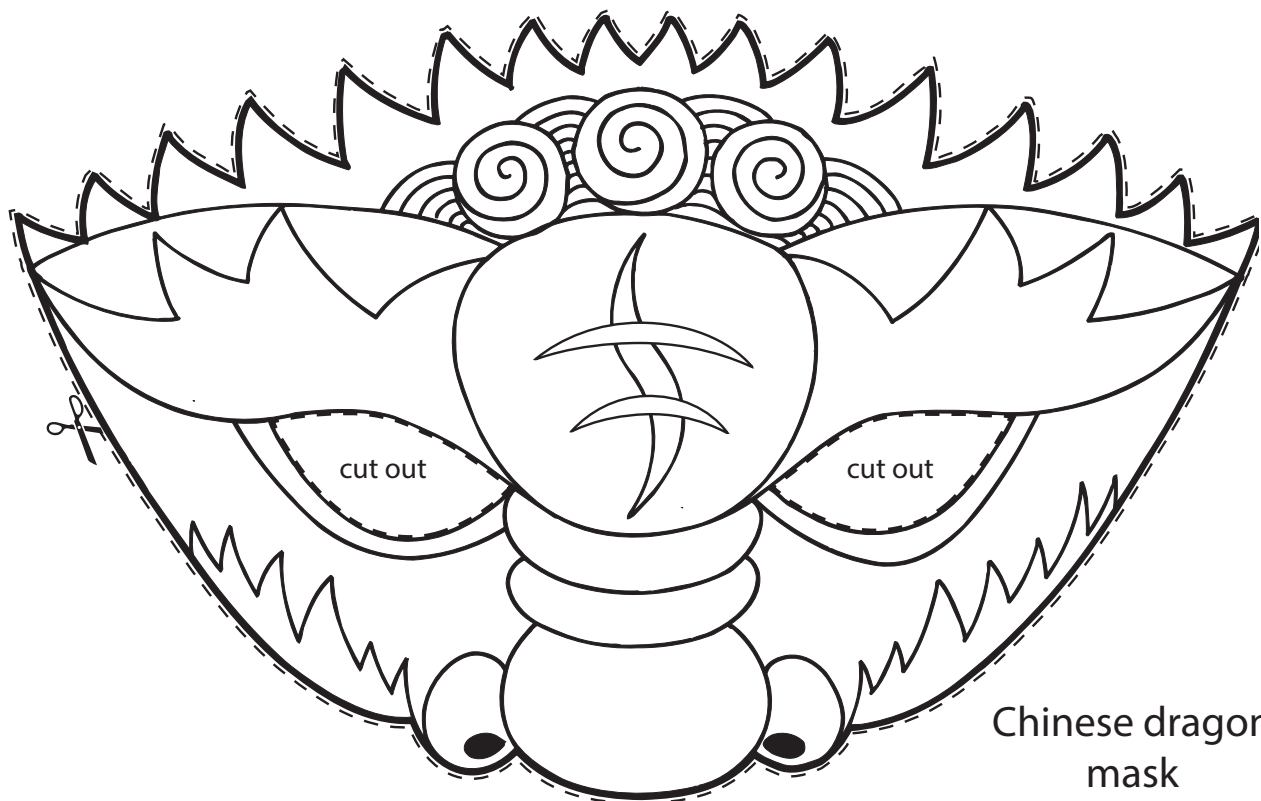
Indicator: Follows instructions to create parts of a clown costume.
Note: Templates are a guide only. Correct sizes will be found by adjusting items to fit the child.

Eye masks

1. Colour and cut out the masks. Glue onto card. Dry. Cut out the eyes.

2. Secure to a wooden skewer, ruler or piece of dowelling or poke holes at the corners and tie on with string or ribbon.

Indicator: Uses manipulative skills to create two masks.
Note: For best results, photocopy onto light card before asking students to colour and cut out.
