



Diagonal joins are the most common type. They join letters with an exit flick to the next letter. When joining letters the entry flicks are not needed at the beginning anymore.

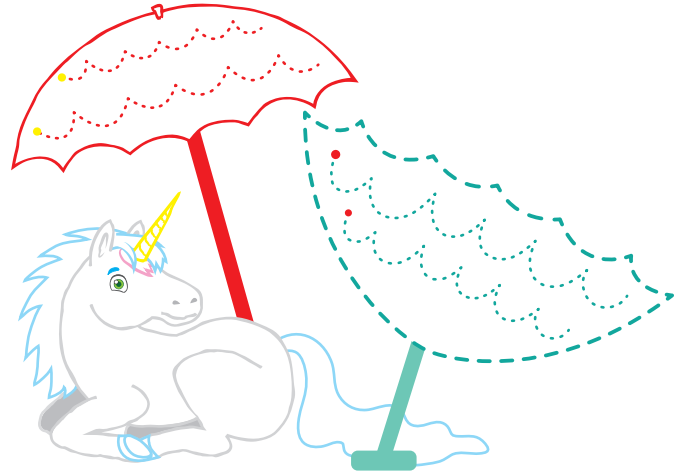

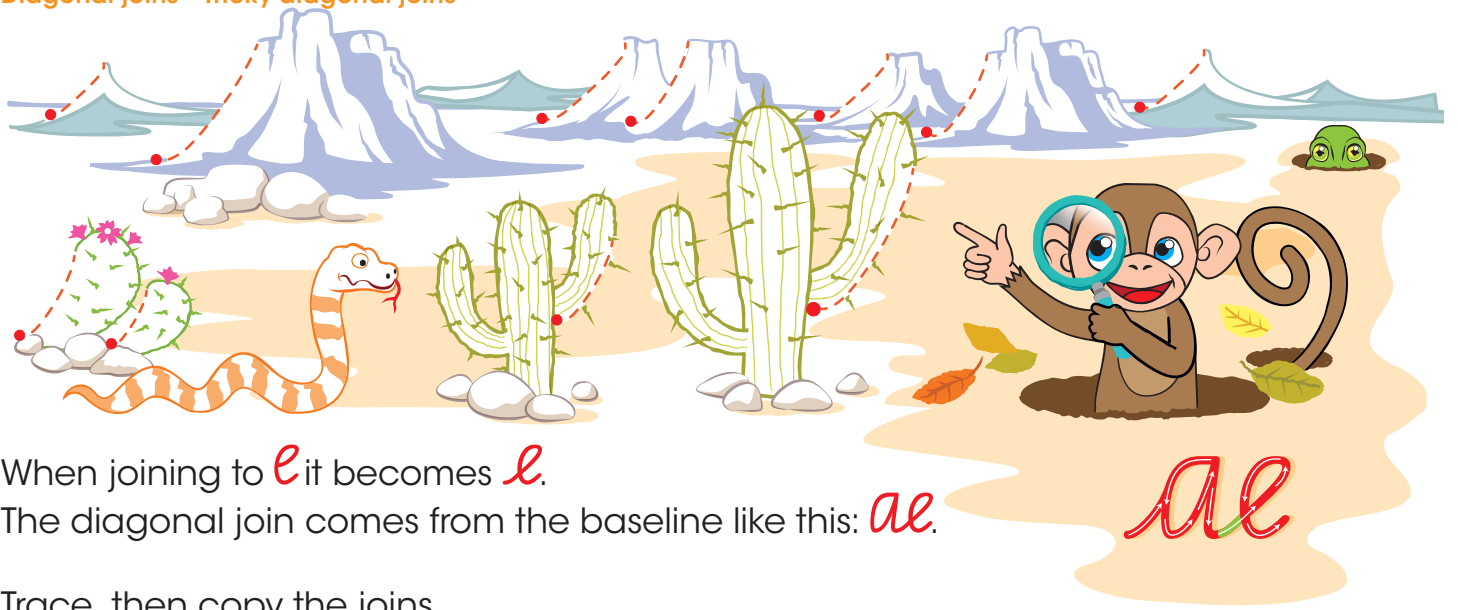

Diagonal joins—Tricky diagonal joins



When joining to *e* it becomes *ae*.

The diagonal join comes from the baseline like this: *ae*.

Trace, then copy the joins.

*ae ne he ee ie lee eew knee*

*leap tea meet heat teen deep*

When joining to *s*, draw the diagonal exit and just retrace back over the top like this: *as*.



Trace, then copy the joins.

*es ns cs as ks ds ts*

*is us ms dis lives this*
